Kasia Kizior is a Polish dance artist based in Berlin. In 2006, she joined Zawirowania Dance Theater, where she worked as a dancer and dance teacher. Her further dance collaborations include productions at the Polish National Opera in Warsaw and the Opera House in Frankfurt am Main. In 2015, she graduated with a Master's Degree in Contemporary Dance Education from the Frankfurt University of Music and Performing Arts (HfMDK). Kasia Kizior became a certified Gaga teacher in Tel Aviv in 2019 under the artistic direction of Saar Harari and Ohad Naharin. She has been a guest teacher with the BA dance department at HfMDK and theaters such as Friedrichstadt-Palast Berlin, Gerhart Hauptmann Theater Görlitz Zittau, and Landestheater Linz. She has also collaborated as a guest rehearsal director at Staatstheater Kassel. Her choreographic works include collaborations with Polish Theater in Posen, television and film productions for networks like TVN (e.g., "So You Think You Can Dance"), Madants Film Production, Platige Image, and Studio Agart. Kasia is a winner of a postgraduate grant for pedagogical research from Hessische Theaterakademie Frankfurt.
