Camilla was born in Cesena, northern Italy. At the age of 13, she moved to Milan to train at the prestigious La Scala Theatre Ballet Academy, where she studied for several years.

Following her time in Milan, she relocated to Reggio Emilia and joined the Agora Coaching Project, a professional contemporary dance school. There, she deepened her understanding of contemporary movement and trained with a diverse range of internationally renowned teachers and choreographers.

In 2020, Camilla moved to Berlin to join the professional contemporary dance program DART DSP, where she trained for one year before being selected as an apprentice with the DART Dance Company.

From 2021 to 2025, she was a full-time member of the company, the co-artistic director, and was also a ballet and contemporary teacher within the programs. In the 2025/2026 season, she transitioned to a project-based role.

Camilla is currently a member of the Berlin-based Der Suchende Dance Collective.

Her experience includes collaborations with choreographers such as Peter Chu, Blenard Azizaj, Anton Lachky, Noa Zuk, Ohad Fishof, Saaed Hani, Emanuele Soavi, Michele Merola, and Ricardo Fernando.
